### Languages in Illinois

- Cook County's 109 languages represented the fifth highest number recorded in any county in the United States. Other Illinois counties that were highly ranked included: DuPage County (t-41), Lake County (t-65), Champaign County (t-146), Will County (t-146), and Kane County (t-174).
- Illinois has the highest percentage of speakers of Lithuanian, Polish and Serbian in the United States. The Land of Lincoln also ranks second in the percentage of Gujarathi, Malayalam, Syriac and Urdu speakers and third in the percentage of Bulgarian and Romanian speakers.
- Cook County has the second highest percentage of Bulgarian and Polish speakers of any county in the nation. Other counties that rank highly in a given language include: DuPage County (third, Gujarathi), Cook County (fourth, Syriac), DuPage County (fourth, Lithuanian) and DuPage County (fourth, Urdu).
