Languages in Kentucky

- Jefferson County's 60 languages tied for the 108th highest number recorded in any county in the United States. Other Kentucky counties that were highly ranked included: Fayette County (t-174) and Warren County (t-478).
- Kentucky has the fourth highest percentage of speakers of English in the United States. The Bluegrass State also ranks fifth in the percentage of Eskimo and Pennsylvania Dutch speakers.
- Warren County has the fourth highest percentage of Serbocroatian speakers of any county in the nation.
