### Languages in Maine

- Cumberland County's 45 languages tied for the 189th highest number recorded in any county in the United States. Other Maine counties that were highly ranked included: Penobscot County (t-350) and York County (t-427).
- Maine has the highest percentage of speakers of French and Micmac in the United States. The Pine Tree State also ranks third in the percentage of Romany and Scottish Gaelic speakers and fourth in the percentage of American Indian speakers.
- Aroostook County has the fourth highest percentage of French speakers of any county in the nation. Other counties that rank highly in a given language include: Washington County (eighth, American Indian), Androscoggin County (11th, French) and Kennebec County (20th, French).
