Languages in Nevada

- Clark County's 84 languages tied for the 25th highest number recorded in any county in the United States. Other Nevada counties that were highly ranked included: Washoe County (t-116) and Carson City (t-650).
- Nevada has the highest percentage of speakers of Paiute and Thai in the United States. The Silver State also ranks second in the percentage of Basque, Bisayan, Bulgarian and Hawaiian speakers and third in the percentage of Chamorro, Shoshoni, Tagalog and Zuni speakers.
- Clark County has the eighth highest percentage of Thai speakers of any county in the nation. Other counties that rank highly in a given language include: Clark County (10th, Hawaiian) and Clark County (10th, Bulgarian).
