Languages in New York

- Queens County's 105 languages represented the sixth highest number recorded in any county in the United States. Other New York counties that were highly ranked included: Kings County (t-11), New York County (t-11), Westchester County (t-35), Nassau County (40), Bronx County (t-41), Suffolk County (t-47), Erie County (t-52), Monroe County (t-68), Onondaga County (t-96), and Richmond County (t-96).
- New York has the highest percentage of speakers of African, Bengali, Caucasian, Greek, Hebrew, Italian, Malayalam, Pakistan (n.e.c.), Pashto, Patois, Russian, Urdu and Yiddish in the United States. The Empire State also ranks second in the percentage of Albanian, Chadic, Chinese, Irish Gaelic, Panjabi and Turkish speakers.
- Queens County has the highest percentage of Bengali and Greek speakers of any county in the nation.
